### Tasting Notes

**Variety**

Cabernet Sauvignon

**Colour**

Dark cherry red

**Winemaker's Notes**

The expressive nose displays ripe black fruit aromas, together with an abundance of aniseed and notes of soft ripe cherries. The palate is finely structured, matching the dashing fruitiness. The tannins are very well balanced and will complement any food style.

**Cellaring**

This youngster is a wonderfully approachable wine now.

**Occasion**

The soft, supple structure of this wine makes it the perfect accompaniment to yum cha or any impromptu Mediterranean casual dining.

**Wine Summary**

Fresh from the Rymill Coonawarra stable, The Yearling is a dashing one year-old Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon. Especially made to present lively, fruity aromas with a soft, supple structure, this vibrant yet approachable wine is absolutely perfect to enjoy now.
