The 2009 Yearling Sauvignon Blanc has a floral and light spicy nose, enhanced by subtle hints of fresh herbs such as dill and lemon grass. These delicious notes carry through to the palate, where they are well balanced by good natural acidity and a fulfilling texture. The wine demonstrates excellent persistence, with a zesty and crisp finish revealing touches of lemon, lime and green papaya also leaving spiciness on the taste buds. More than just a pretty face!
