Variety

Shiraz

Colour

Deep purple with magenta hues

Winemakers' Notes

The vibrant nose of ripe berry fruits is enhanced by hints of fresh aniseed and spice mixed with touches of caramel and toffee. The bouquet perseveres with aromas of freshly cut Italian herbs, including parsley and oregano, and black fruit compote and smoky cedar box. The same juicy red fruit flavours and spice then dominate the palate. A substantial mouth feel, and soft, round tannins are perfectly balanced together to provide a delicious and persistent finish.

Cellaring

This red wine has been specially made to enjoy now.

Occasion

Recommended around a BBQ with marinated steaks, shashliks and good company.

Fresh from the Rymill Coonawarra stable, the Yearling is a gallant one year-old Coonawarra Shiraz. Made from estate-grown fruit, this spicy and appealing wine is absolutely perfect to enjoy now.
