**Variety**

Cabernet Sauvignon

**Colour**

Dark cherry red

**Winemakers' Notes**

The quintessential Cabernet Sauvignon nose displays ripe raspberry and black fruit aromas, together with an abundance of dark chocolate and notes of soft ripe cherries. The raspberry and chocolate aromas are once again apparent in the mouth with a subtle herbal infusion. The palate is finely structured and well integrated with classic Coonawarra dusty tannins matching the dashing fruitiness and spiciness. The acid line is very well balanced with a plump mid-palate and will complement any food style.

**Cellaring**

This youngster is a wonderfully approachable wine now.

**Occasion**

The soft, supple structure of this wine makes it the perfect accompaniment to yum cha or any impromptu Mediterranean casual dining.
