There is nothing more refreshing than a glass of the 2010 The Yearling Sauvignon Blanc. This wine has whiffs of tropical fruits, fresh herbal notes, and spices. It is a fragrant wine revealing particulars of citrus fruit, peach, musk stick, fennel, and pink grapefruit. Aromas spill onto the palate showing glimmers of fruit sweetness and dessert spices. With its crisp, lean, lemon-lime acid, it also encompasses a softness and roundness on the palate that carries all the flavours, right down through all of your taste buds.
