The 2006 Sauvignon Blanc is a balanced and harmonious wine that encapsulates the full spectrum of flavours.

The 2003 mc² is a blend of merlot, cabernet sauvignon and cabernet franc and is extremely versatile.

The 2002 Shiraz is mouth filling, with good definition and outstanding flavour making it a great example of the 2002 vintage.

All in all these are three complex wines at reasonable prices.
